His Story

Thomas Bebbington was born in 1883 in Middlewich. In 1891 he was at The Green, Sproston aged 8 and at school.

He was living with his mother, Caroline Bebbington who was a widow working as a grocer.

By 1901 he was living in the Village of Holmes Chapel at Bridge Farm, the house of George Ellison and working as a servant (general labourer) aged 18. By 1911 he was at Stockery Farm, Davenport aged 23 and married although his new wife is not living at the farm. His age is likely to be a mis- print as he was 28 by this date. (Note in 1911 census Caroline Bebbington his mother was living alone at Macclesfield Rd, Holmes Chapel, aged 69, and mother of 6 children.)

His War Record

The only information obtained about his war record is that he was called up in March 1917 according to the Parish magazine.
