His Story

Frederick was born in 1897 at Cheetham Hill, Manchester to Elizabeth and Archibald Bishop. Archibald was a commercial traveller originating from London.

In 1901 he was living at Park House Cranage aged 4. By 1905 the family had moved to Park View Cranage and in 1911 Frederick was at Fir Tree Cottage, Station Road, Church Hulme living with brother Stanley Thomas Bishop, aged 14 and at school.

His War Record

The Parish Magazine records that in November 1915 he was just enlisted into the Royal Flying Corps. The magazine noted that "We would heartily congratulate Mr and Mrs Bishop that they now have five sons serving the country".

In June 1918 he was reported to be abroad but there is no further news.

The Absent Voters list 1919 confirms his address was Station Road. He was now a gunner, Nr 63845, HQS, Royal Garrison Artillery 70th Brigade.
