His Story

Richard B Bright was born in 1890 Salford to William (a warehouseman) and Fanny Bright. In 1901 he was living at 22 Stowell Street, Pendleton aged 10 with his younger brother Hubert. By 1911 he was living in Salford with his widowed mother and two siblings. He was aged 20 and working as a copper roller engraver's apprentice at a wallpaper works.

Possibly, as a result of his work in the wallpaper industry the family moved to Holmes Chapel to the new wallpaper works. His address is taken to be the same as his brother Hubert's in Middlewich Road.

His marriage is recorded in 1924 to Ida Henshaw in the Congleton District.

He probably died in Darwen Lancashire in 1945 aged 53.

His War Record

The Parish Magazine reported that in April 1916 he was with the Army Ordnance Corps. In June 1916 he was in hospital going on well. He was still in hospital in July 1916 but satisfactory.

There were no further reports.
