His Story

Lot was born in February 1877, the son of Joseph and Sarah Clarke of Twemlow Lane Cranage and one of a family of 8 siblings.

In 1891 he was a farm servant at John Ford's farm in Moss Lane Cranage and was still a servant there in 1901.

In 1905 he married Ann Bentley and by 1911 he had taken up work as a farm labourer at Handforth. He died in 1959 in Crewe at the age of 82 and was buried at Church Hulme

His War Record

We have no knowledge of his war record except that he joined up in early 1917 and on the 5 September he was discharged as "no longer fit for war service".

His name is recorded on the Church Roll of Honour.
