His Story

Very little is known about Harold. He was born on the 8th April 1894 in Woodhouse, Davenport, Church Hulme, the son of Joseph (a farmer) and Suzannah and the second eldest of 4 brothers.

He was still living there at the time of the censuses in 1901 and 1911. By 1911 he was aged 17 and working for his father on the farm.

He returned to the area after the war and eventually died in the Crewe district in 1968 aged 72.

His War Record

We have no record as to when he joined up, but know that on the 4th July 1916 he received a gunshot wound to his right leg.
