His Story

Claud was born about 1901 at Portsmouth, the son of Charles William Killick and Eva Ethel Killick, neé Knights. The family moved to Suffolk soon after he was born, where his two siblings were born and his father died in 1905.

In the 1911 Census the family were living at 99 Denmark Road, Beccles, Suffolk the home of his grandfather James Edward Knights.

His mother, a nurse, married Uriah Plant, widower, at Church Hulme on 11 February 1911. Thus Claud's connection with Holmes Chapel is his mother's second marriage.

His War Record

Claud is recorded on the Church Roll of Honour but there is no reference to him in the Parish Magazine.
