His Story

Thomas had been born in Church Hulme in 1879 to Thomas and Isabelle Merrill.

In 1891 he was living with the family including his brother Frank at Station Houses, Holmes Chapel and he was a scholar aged 12.

In 1901 the family had moved to Macclesfield Road and both Frank (aged 16) and his brother Thomas (aged 22) were working as grooms.

In 1911 he was living with his widowed mother and working as a Labourer/Coal carter.

His burial is recorded on the 18th December 1935 at Church Hulme aged 56.

His War Record

The first information in the Parish Magazine is that he was still in hospital in January 1918 but we have no information as to why.

He was discharged in March but back in hospital again in May where he stayed until August 1918 when he was discharged and returned to duty.
