His Story

Harry was born about 1891 at Holmes Chapel, the son of John and Elizabeth Postles. John's occupation was described as 'Hot Water Fitter'

He is recorded at Holmes Chapel in the 1891, 1901 and 1911 Census. In 1901 he was living with the family in Middlewich Road and John, his father, had now changed his trade to Smith (general).

By 1911 Harry was aged 20 and working as a house joiner. His father was now a 'Hot Water Pipe Fitter'!

His War Record

Harry joined the Army Ordnance Corps in April 1915.

In March 1916 he was reported in hospital wounded but doing well. In April he was improving and in June 1916 he was out of hospital and doing well.

There were no further reports.
