His Story

Richard, son of Samuel and Margaret, was born in Holmes Chapel in Aug 1897. He spent his early life at a home on Congleton Road, but by 1911 the family were living at Church View in the centre of the village, behind St Luke's Church. Richard was aged 13 and at school. His father, Samuel, was a coal and produce merchant's manager.

After the war Richard returned and in May 1922 married Hilda Mountfield.

He died in Crewe area in February 1963 aged 66.

His War Record

We know very little of his war record, but Richard enlisted into the Army Ordnance Corps in November 1915.

According to the Absent Voters list in 1919 he was still a private in the AOC with Nr. 011442.
