His Story

We know very little about Fred, but he was born on 30 March 1899 in Nantwich, son of Charles and Sarah Turner, and we know that he was living in 1901 at 7 Shrewsbury Lane, Nantwich aged two.

By 1911 he was living in Cranage and attending school there. His address was Hermitage Cottage.

After the war he returned to the area and was buried on the 14th November 1921 in Church Hulme aged only 22.

His War Record

Fred attested in 1916 aged 17yrs 11 months and in 1917 at the age of 18yrs 1 month he joined Kings Liverpool Regiment, number 198982.

In June 1917 he was posted to the 14th Battalion Royal Rifle Brigade, number 46580 and the following December to the Army Service Corps.

He was demobilised on 27 September 1919.
