## **His Story**

Maelgwn was one of four brothers from the Williams grocery family who served in the war. The Cambrian Stores was at the side of the original George and Dragon Public House.

He was born in 1893 at Holmes Chapel and was educated in the village. By the age of 18, in 1911, he was working as a grocer. He returned to the business after his wartime service.

He died in 1984 aged 91 in Holmes Chapel.

## **His War Record**

There are no details of Maelgwyn's wartime service other than his name in the Roll of Honour and we know that he joined the Royal Field Artillery.

He returned to civilian life without being wounded.
