His Story

Jesse, son of William and Ellen Winstanley, was one of three brothers who served in the war. He was born in August 1886 at Byley.

He was living at Cranage by the age of 4 in 1891, and became a bootmaker, as recorded in the census of 1911.

After the war, in February 1919, he married Ellen Vickers, possibly in Macclesfield. He died in February 1954 aged 67.

His War Record

Jesse joined the Army Service Corps in June 1915 but it is not known where or how he served.

He was in hospital in January 1918 and was discharged from the ASC in March of that year, suffering from rheumatism.

His service was noted in the Parish Magazine and his name appears on the Roll of Honour.
